CLLL’s Board of Directors is comprised of 15 volunteers that dedicate their hard work to the betterment of all players and families within our baseball community. Our goal is to grow our league, create a baseball learning environment that promotes positive sportsmanship and a love of the game while promoting the spirit of Little League.

Each year the league holds it’s Annual Meeting, think State of the Union, where the President shares updates and information from the previous year. Board of Directors elections are held at this time, as well. Any member registered with CLLL and is in good standing is eligible to run for the Board. The elections are structured so that there are always 5 members who are returning to the Board so that continuity can occur.

Per CLLL’s constitution, the Board meets monthly to discuss pertinent information for the upcoming seasons. Topics include, but not limited to: Registration, Manager Selection, Facility Updates, League Calendar, Uniforms, Coaching education, and upcoming Special Events. Each Board member gives a report, lengthy discussions are had to make sure we are in compliance with our local rules and the Little League rule book, votes occur when needed and an overall league status is assessed. It may not always appear so, but the Board is charged with making sure we are player focused for over 900 players in the league. The first 15 minutes of each meeting are dedicated to “Public Session.” At this time, members of the CLLL community are invited to come speak with the Board about any questions or concerns they may have.
