## **CLLL PLAYOFF PROCEDURES**

## Major Leagues and AAA

- A. Little League and local league rules will apply throughout the playoffs.
- B. Little League and local pitching rules and regulations govern all playoff games.
- C. If a playoff game, which is halted by the umpire for reasons of weather or darkness, shall be considered complete, if 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> innings are complete with the home team leading or after 4 innings.
- D. The Chief Umpire, with the approval of the League President, will appoint the playoff officials.
- E. A protest committee in place of the BOD shall govern all playoff games. The League President will appoint members of the committee.
- F. AAA playoff games will have no time limits
- G. Order of precedence for playoff seeding in the event of a tie:
  - a. The team with the better winning percentage on all games
  - b. The team with the better record in head to head games will receive the higher seeding.
  - c. In the event the head to head record is equal, the team with the better winning percentage within the division will receive the higher seeding.
  - d. In the event the in division records are equal, then the team that gave up the fewest number of runs in the regular season shall receive the higher seeding.
  - e. In the event that the teams gave up the same number of runs during the regular season, the flip of a coin shall be performed to determine the higher seeding.
- H. Home Team for the Championship:
  - a. Team with the highest winning percentage
  - b. Runs against for the season
  - c. Coin Toss

## AA and A

- A. Little League and local league rules will apply throughout the playoffs.

  - a. Team with the highest winning percentage
  - b. Runs against for the season
  - c. Coin Toss
