



Topic: The District

CLLL is a part of Little League's Virginia District 16. This is the 4th largest District in the state. Virginia is a part of the Southeast Region of Little League International. District 16 comprises Dulles, Upper Loudoun, Lower Loudoun, Loudoun South, and Greater Fauquier little leagues. CLLL used to be a part of District 3, yet as Loudoun County grew, so did baseball and the need to expand the number of districts in the state. CLLL is overseen by District Administrator, LaMott Smith. The District Administrator is our direct line to the State, Southeast Region, and Little League International. CLLL is fortunate to have Mr. Smith as our administrator, as he is a former President of CLLL when his own children played in CLLL. The District Administrator has a staff that consults with, supports, and guides the local leagues.

An important function of the District is to see that the rules, regulations, and spirit of Little League is administered and enforced throughout the leagues that are within the jurisdiction of the District. The District is not here to run each league; it is here to assist each league in running their affairs. It is also obliged to ensure that Little League International's standards and vision for the Little League program are adhered to in each league, from safety, to the selection of All Stars, to the drafting of teams, to the election of board members and officers.
